Law Of The Republic Of Indonesia Number 19 Of 2003 Concerning State-Owned Entities

Chapter 28

- (1) A member of the Board of Commissioners shall be appointed in consideration of his/her integrity, dedication, awareness of management problems with respect to any of the managerial functions, adequate knowledge in the line of business of that State-Owned Limited Liability Company (Persero), and ability to allow sufficient time to perform his/her duties.
- (2) The composition of the Board of Commissioners must be determined in such manner that allows any decision to be made effectively, accurately and quickly, and allows them to act independently.
- (3) The term of office of a member of the Board of Commissioners shall be for 5 (five) years and she/he may be re-appointed for I (one) term of office.
- (4) Where the Board or Commissioners consists of more than one member, any or the members or the Board or Commissioners shall be appointed as president commissioner.
- (5) No appointment of a member of the Board of Commissioners shall be made concurrently with the appointment of a member of the Board of Directors, except for initial appointment at the time of establishment.
